

MOVIE POSTER

Create a movie poster based on your book that includes the following information:

- Title of the book
- Author
- Title of the movie (Maybe it's the same, maybe it's a title that you think would be appealing. If you choose to change the title, be sure to include something like, "based on the novel...".)
- Movie Director
- Identify the main characters (at least three), list the characters' names and the actors who would play them
- A large visual of some kind. It can be a literal depiction of action from the book, more suggestive or abstract, or it can focus on just one important symbol, place, person, object...
- Two ratings
 - The first rating is on a scale of 1-10 on how well you enjoyed the book (you could do stars or thumbs up...)
 - The second rating is like a movie rating, but you will devise your own. For example, a story about a king and queen who lose their princess daughter might be rated RS for "Royally Sad." A book that is action packed and filled with twists and turns may be rated, EE for "Extremely Exciting."
- A quote from the book that is interesting, intriguing, and gets people interested in it. (Don't forget to include the page number!)
- Your movie poster needs to be the size of a regular poster board. It should be bright, colorful, and attention getting.
