

Finalizing your video for playback on the computer

1. Open Windows Movie Maker. Import your video and drag to the storyboard at the bottom of the screen.
2. Under 'Finish Movie,' click 'Save to my computer.'
3. Name your movie file. Browse to your student number folder.
4. Click 'Next' to start saving your movie.
5. Your file will save as a .wmv file, which is playable in Windows Media Player (on all computers in the library). This file can also be put into Power Point presentations and other Windows applications.
6. Note: Follow the same steps above to save to a flash stick; just 'Browse' to the flash stick drive rather than your student folder.

Saving your video to a CD

Note: Saving your video on a CD will NOT necessarily play in a DVD player. This is only to store the video as a file that can be played on other computers.

1. Insert a recordable CD into the CD drive.
2. Under 'Finish Movie,' click 'Save to CD.'
3. Name your movie file and the CD.
4. Click 'Next' to start saving your movie.
