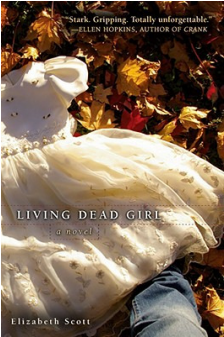
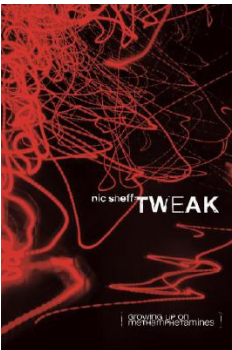

Alice, a fifteen-year-old girl who was abducted by Ray when she was ten, lives in fear of what he is going to do to her and hopes death will save her from the nightmare.



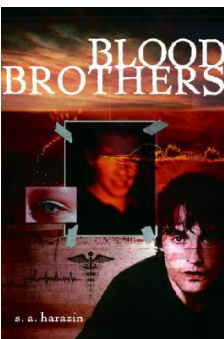
## **Tweak by Nic Sheff** **362.29 SHE**

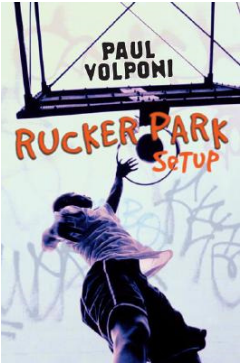
## **Blood Brothers by S.A. Harazin** **FIC HAR**

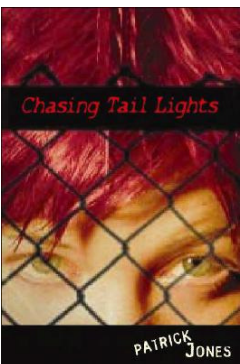
**Go Ask Alice**

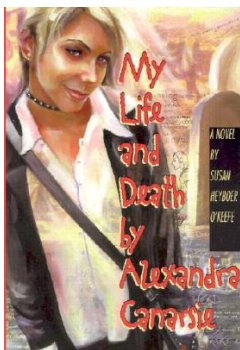
**Rucker Park Setup by Paul Volponi**

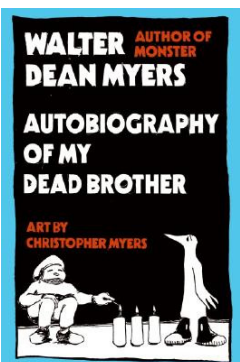
**Chasing Tail Lights by Patrick Jones**

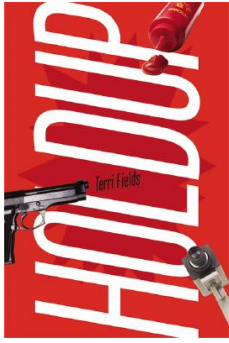
**My Life and Death by Alexandra Carnarsie by Susan O'Keefe**

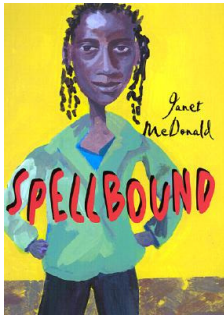
Jesse pours his heart and soul into his sketchbook to make sense of life in his troubled Harlem neighborhood and the loss of a close friend.

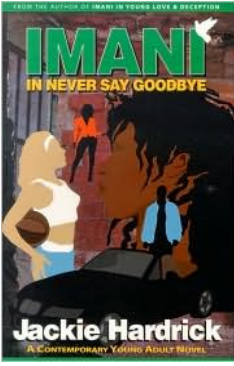
After a meteor hits the moon and sets off a series of horrific climate changes, seventeen-year-old Alex Morales must take care of his sisters alone in the chaos of New York City.



### **Saint Iggy by K.L. Going**

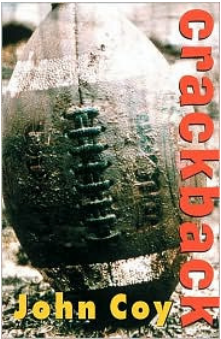

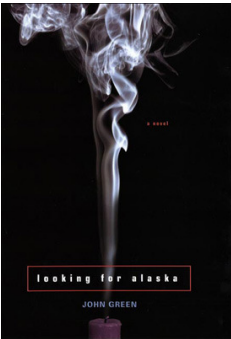
**Imani in Never Say Goodbye by Jackie Hardrick**

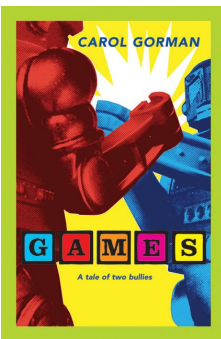
**Crackback by John Coy**

Miles barely recalls when football was fun after being sidelined by a new coach, constantly criticized by his father, and pressured by his best friend to take performance-enhancing drugs.



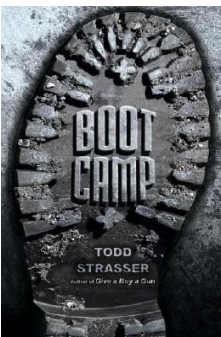
**Looking for Alaska by John Green**
